Papers







The ANQ Congress is always based on technical papers, whether academic, conceptual or representing case studies. This Congress had many number of papers. The Program Committee includes members from ANQ member countries. Each country association selects abstracts from

what they receive, and then full papers are submitted by the authors. After severe screening, we still had a large number of papers. As oral presentations are to be necessarily limited, many papers are accepted for presentation in posters for which arrangements were made at the venue.

On the first day there were 15 parallel tracks, and on the second day, 15. There were a total of 30 sessions in these tracks, typically with three-four papers each.

A total of 97 papers were presented in these sessions. 60 papers were presented as posters in the foyer at allotted times.
